

Fondevila Galeria de Arte is pleased to present Divas, an eclectic and fascinating annual international exhibition, taking place in João Pessoa, Paraíba, Brazil, from March 9 to April 9, 2024, an exhibition dedicated to honoring women in his days, which stand out for his courage, dedication and importance in history and society.

The exhibition features the participation of Brazilian artist Maurilio Moreira Fondevila, who wears creations inspired by and characterized by the use of bright and contrasting colors, and by the representation of musical instruments, landscapes, fauna and flora from his native Brazil. His tribute is implicitly represented by the divas who influenced his life and career. Maurilio is a painter and visual artist, characterized by expressiveness, color and imagination. His paintings reflect his personal vision of the world, his emotions and his dreams, using different techniques and materials, such as oil, acrylic, collage and sculpture. He currently resides in Los Angeles, United States, and has exhibited in important cities in Brazil and abroad.

In Divas, Fondevila pays homage to the central element of the exhibition: iconic women, divas of great prestige and importance such as Margarida Maria Alves, Zezita Matos, Ceres Leão, without forgetting the eternal Marilyn Monroe and Fridha Kahlo, through portraits that capture their essence and personality. Each work is an invitation and a unique opportunity to learn about the history, achievements and challenges of these outstanding women, who have been references for empowerment, creativity and social transformation.

Divas is an exhibition that celebrates diversity, beauty and female talent, and which seeks to generate a meaningful and enriching experience for the public, through works of art, rich in metaphors and fluid allusions to the inherent human capacity to create, combining a chromatic game between the emotions of those who admire the work, and the ideas that are revealed through the names of the works and the artist's message.

The Divas exhibition seeks to generate a meaningful and enriching experience for the public, who will be able to admire diversity, beauty and female talent, which is why we invite you to visit it and enjoy the works of Maurilio Moreira Fondevila, an artist who pays homage to women with your art.

Biography by Maurilio

Maurilio Moreira Fondevila was born in Belo Horizonte, MG, Brazil, on July 14, 1965.

It all started with drawings on scrap paper and scribbles on the walls at home. In 1985 he completed his first painting: acrylic "Sagrado" 40x28 inches – surrealist this work was sold in September 1987 during the exhibition at the restaurant "La Grepia Galeria" in Belo Horizonte, Brazil. In August 1995 and May 1997 I returned to "La Grepia" with an exhibition and sold "Galo do Pantanal" and "Clown" in acrylic on canvas.

Maurilio Moreira Fondevila's artistic creations are distinguished by their expressive nature, vibrant colors and imaginative qualities. His works serve as a mirror for his unique perspective on the world, capturing his emotions and dreams. Moreira employs a variety of techniques and materials, including oil and acrylic paints, collages and sculptures. His artistic style crosses several genres, encompassing surrealism, abstract art, figurative pieces and pop art.
