Sesc Paraíba is honored to invite Fondevila Galerias de Arte to present Divas, an eclectic and fascinating annual international exhibition, taking place in João Pessoa, Paraíba, Brazil, from March 8, 2024, being an exhibition dedicated to honoring the women in their day, who stand out for their courage, dedication and importance in history and society.

The exhibition features the participation of Brazilian artist Maurilio Moreira Fondevila, who brings with it creations inspired by and characterized by the use of bright and contrasting colors, and represents musical instruments, landscapes, fauna and flora from her native Brazil. His tribute is implicitly represented by the divas who influenced his life and career.

Maurilio is a painter and visual artist, characterized by expressiveness, color and imagination. His paintings reflect his personal vision of the world, his emotions and his dreams, using different techniques and materials, such as oil, acrylic, collage and sculpture. Currently resides in Los Angeles, United States, and has already exhibited in important cities in Brazil and abroad.

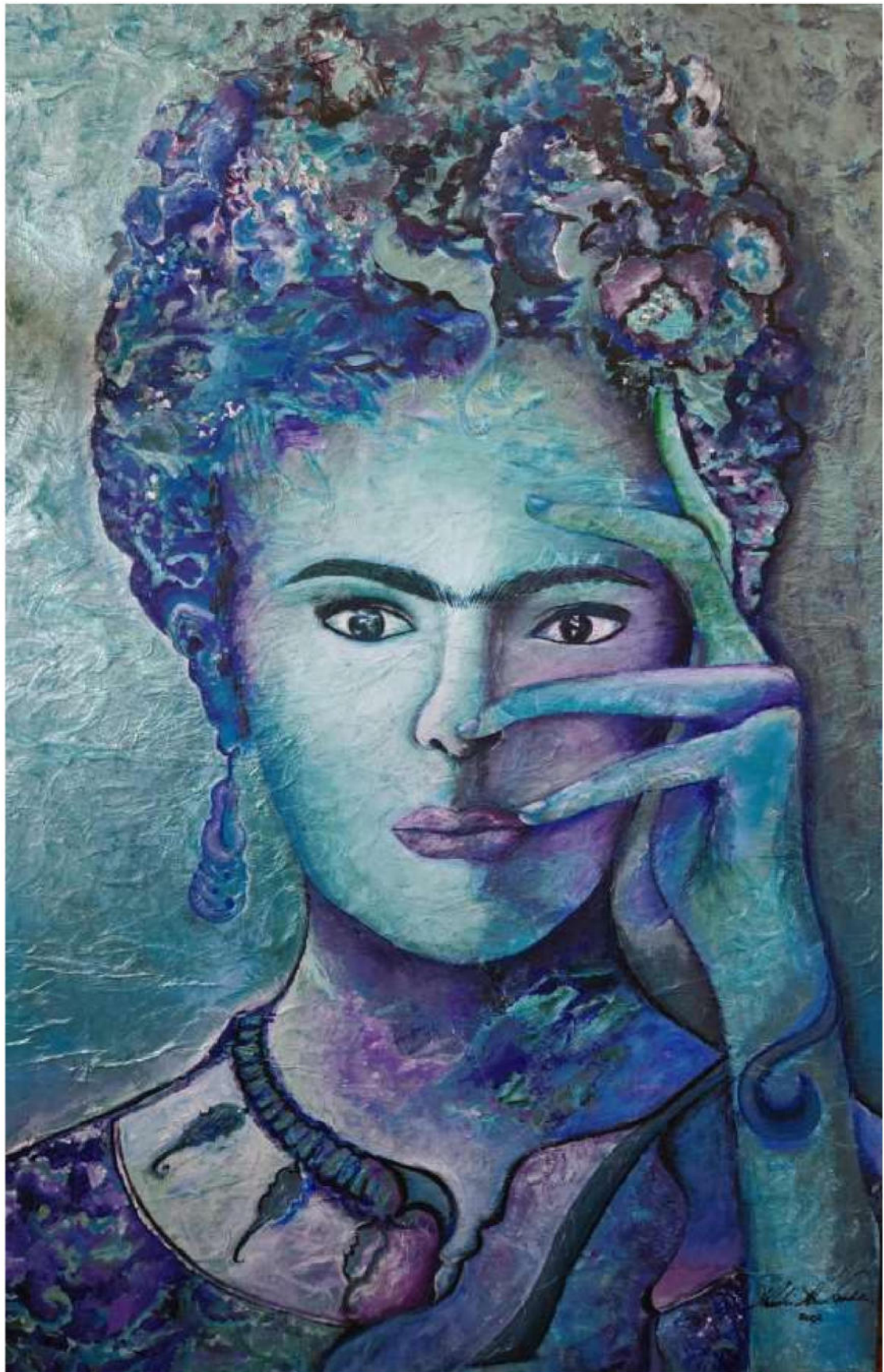
In 'Divas,' Fondevila pays homage to the central element of the exhibition: iconic women, divas of great prestige and importance such as Margarida Maria Alves, Zezita Matos, Ceres Leão, not forgetting the eternal divas Marilyn Monroe and Frida Kahlo. These portraits capture their essence and personality. Each work is an invitation and a unique opportunity to learn about the history, achievements, and challenges of these prominent women, who have been references for empowerment, creativity, and social transformation.

Divas' is an exhibition that celebrates diversity, beauty, and female talent. It aims to create a meaningful and enriching experience for the audience through art pieces rich in metaphors and subtle allusions to the inherent human capacity for creation. The interplay of emotions felt by those who admire the artwork and the ideas revealed through the titles of the pieces and the artist's message adds a chromatic dimension. We invite you to visit the exhibition and appreciate the works of Maurilio Moreira Fondevila, an artist who honors women through his art.

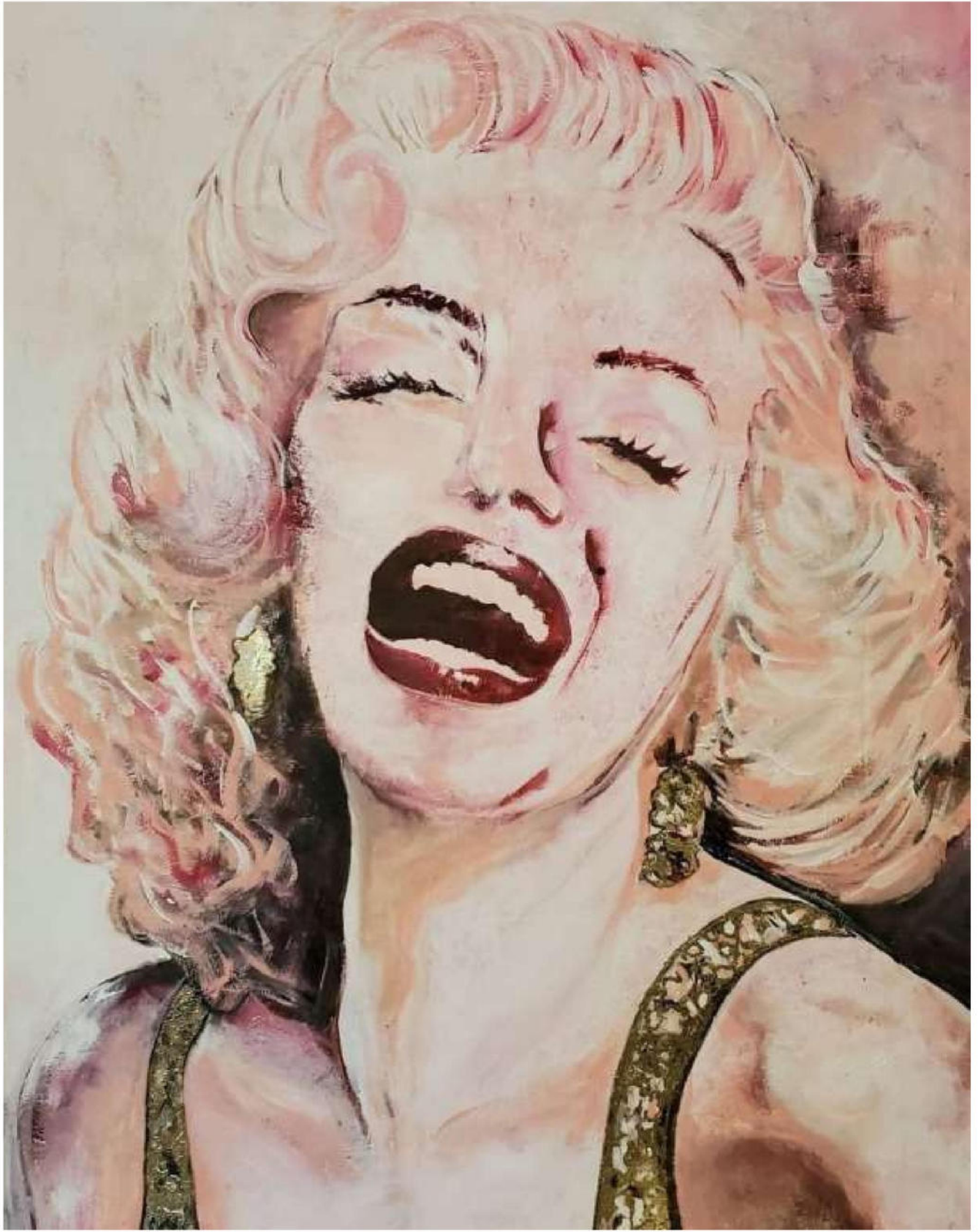

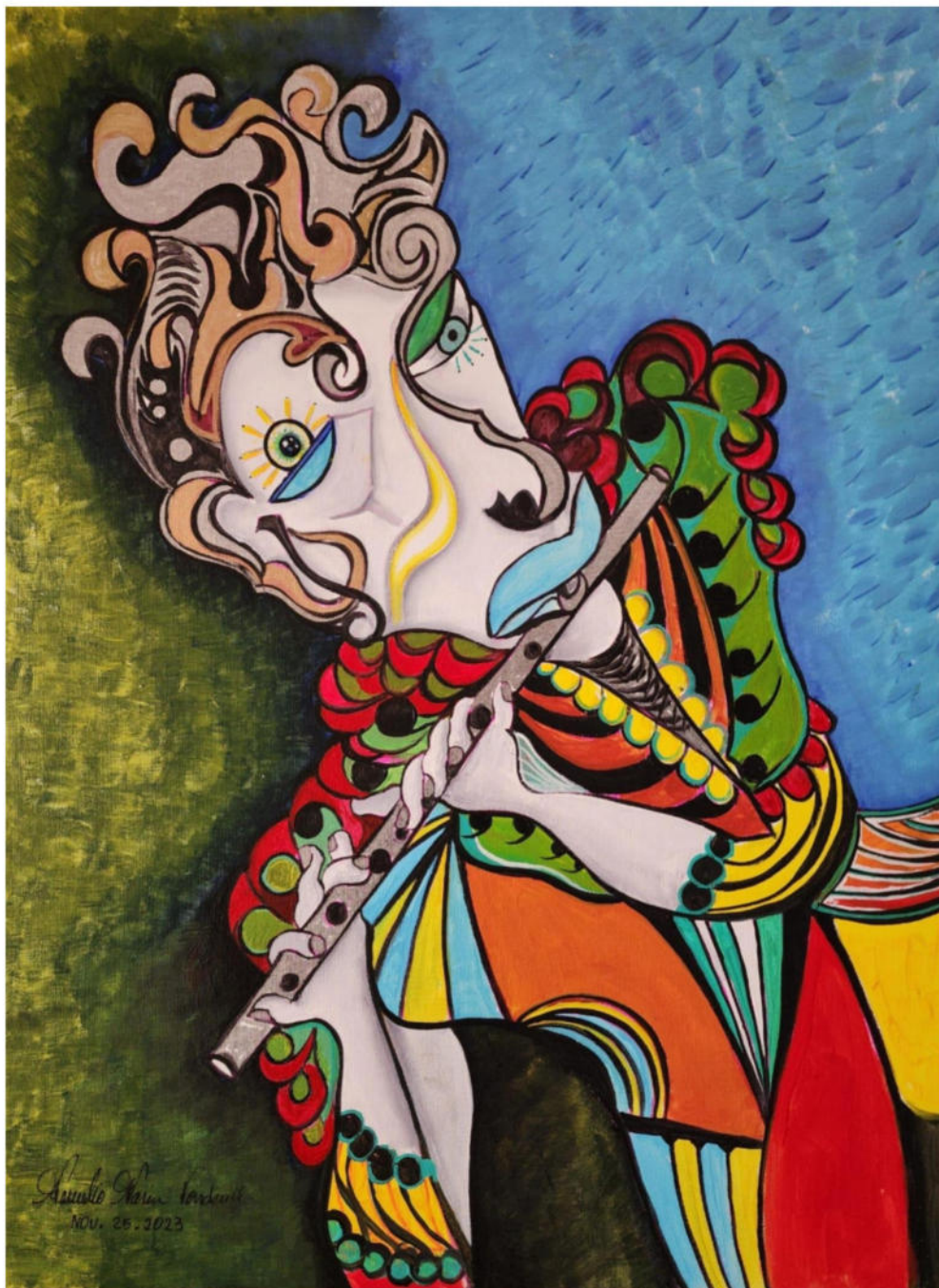

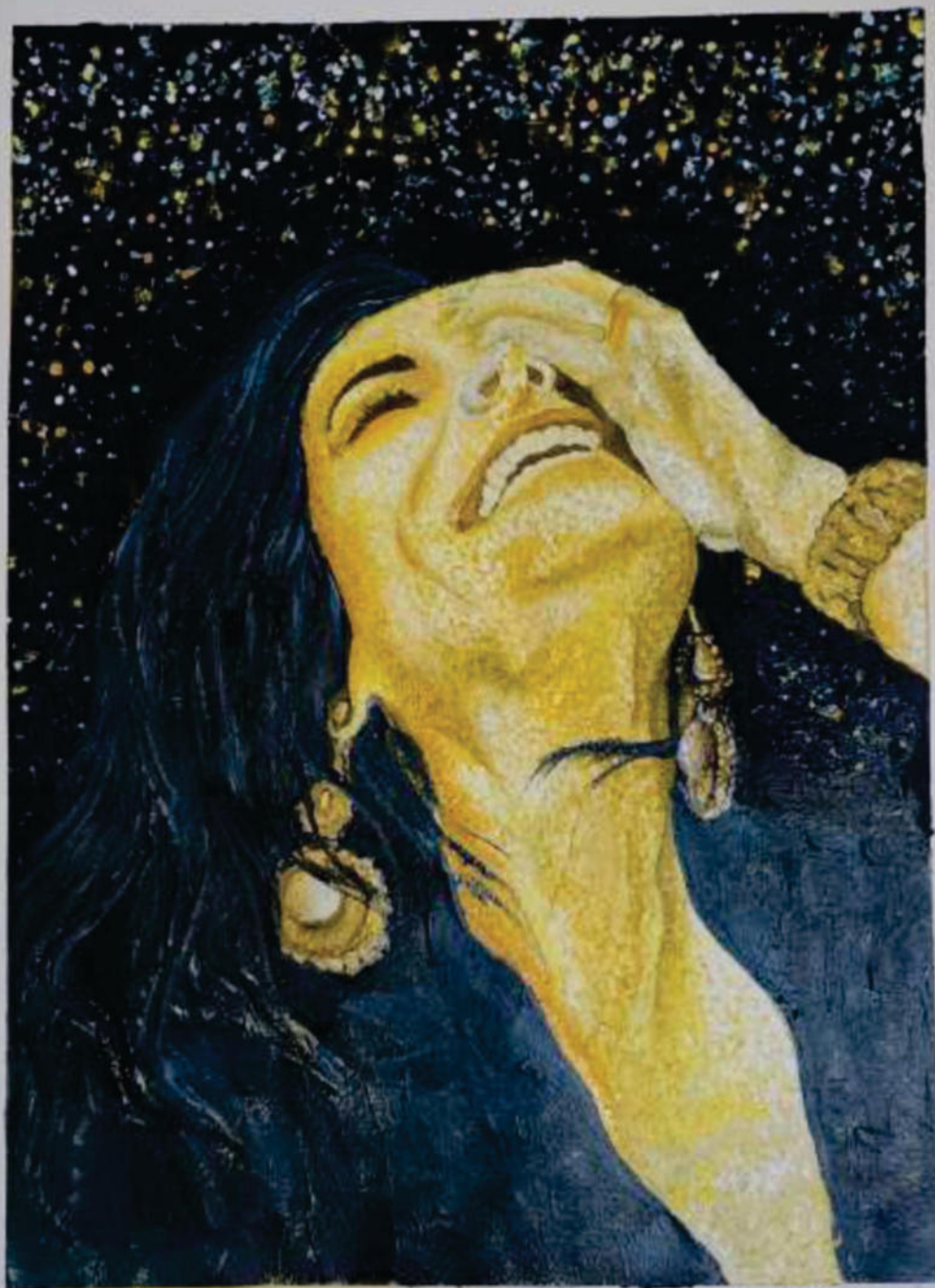

Maurilio Moreira Fondevila was born in Belo Horizonte, MG, on July 14, 1965.

It all started when he was a child, with drawings on scrap paper and scribbles on the walls at home. In 1985 he began his first professional career: "Sacred" acrylic 40x28 inches - surrealist work was sold in September 1987 during the exhibition at the restaurant La Grepia Galeria", in Belo Horizonte.

Maurilio Moreira Fondevila's art is characterized by expressiveness, color and imagination. His paintings reflect his personal view of the world, his emotions and his dreams. Moreira uses different techniques and materials, such as oil, acrylic, collage and sculpture.

His style is varied, ranging from surrealism to abstract, including figurative and pop art. participated in several group exhibitions individuals, in Brazil and abroad.
